

Responsible Dog Ownership

Never tie your dog and leave him unattended.

Never leave your dog in a closed up vehicle on a warm day.

Obey leash laws and other rules when your dog accompanies you to a park or other public place where dogs are allowed.

Do not allow your dog to harass wildlife.

Do not let your dog be a nuisance.

Always be courteous when you are with your dog in public.

Do not let your dog urinate on any building. Do not let your dog relieve himself inside any building. Make sure your dog has had ample opportunity to do his duty in a proper place.

Carry clean-up baggies with you where ever you go, and dispose of your dog's droppings properly.
